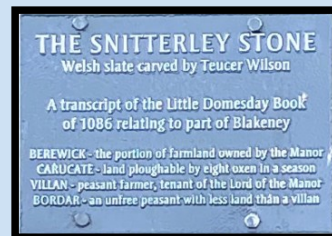

Royalty in the Autumn.
